What is Adopt A Room?



Adopting a Room provides the Toowoomba Hospice with financial assistance to maintain client facilities and to provide professional palliative care.

Your adoption will be used to maintain a fresh and comfortable home like environment for those who need it the most.

This may include:

- Fresh Paint and Touch ups!
- Updating Carpet/Flooring
- Linen
- Purchase of furnishings/furniture
- General maintenance & upkeep
- Clinical consumables
- Periodic professional cleaning
- 24 hr. nursing care
- Flowers

What is a Hospice?

The Toowoomba Hospice was built at a cost of \$1.2 million and provides six beds to people in their final stages of life.

The Toowoomba Hospice has been designed to provide a home-like atmosphere for clients, their family and friends.

The building stands as a witness to the community's respect for the sacredness of human life, for its concern for those very vulnerable people who need loving care and support through perhaps the most difficult phase of their lives.

The building was constructed with three interconnecting sections: administration, services section and the client suites.

Administration houses office space, a board room and the reflection room.

The services section includes the kitchen, laundry facility, storage room and a family suite.

The client suites are large and are subtly different to accommodate individual client needs. All have their own bathroom and enjoy plenty of natural light. Each suite is equipped with reverse-cycle air-conditioner, tv, small fridge, recliner chair and a specialized bed for client comfort and care.
